TIPS ON HOW TO KEEP YOUR HOME SAFE:

- Keep all windows locked, regardless of the level they're on
- If you have a window AC unit that can't be removed in the winter, make sure it is bolted in to the wall
- Keep doors locked ... use a deadbolt if possible.
- Never keep objects close to windows that are easy to climb on (i.e garbage pails, ladders, outdoor furniture)
- Improve the security of your home (invest in an alarm system and exterior cameras)
- Keep the interior and exterior of your home well lit
- Keep trees and shrubs pruned to prevent a burglar from hiding
- Identify any potential points of vulnerability and correct those weaknesses
