Incident: Weapon Arrest

Bloomfield, NJ- Bloomfield Police responded to the Home Depot regarding an individual in possession of a handgun. The complaint was made by the store's security guard, who observed a group of individuals arguing in the parking lot. During the altercation, the security guard saw one individual remove an object from a parked vehicle that appeared to be a handgun. Upon the arrival of police, the individual was located inside the store and identified as Mr. Jason Agyemang of Newark, NJ. After being detained, Mr. Agyemang was questioned about possessing a firearm, to which he admitted he was carrying one without a permit. The firearm, a .357 Smith & Wesson revolver, was secured without incident. A subsequent consensual search of the vehicle Mr. Agyemang had been associated with revealed a set of brass knuckles. Mr. Agyemang was arrested and transported to the county jail. Charges were filed for possession of a weapon, possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose, certain persons not to have weapons, and making terroristic threats. Mr. Agyemang is awaiting a Superior Court hearing.
