Alternate Side-of-the-Street Parking:

It's not just for street sweeping

The Bloomfield Police Department reminds everyone that alternate-side parking serves multiple purposes, including (but not limited to):

- Water main and curb box repair
- Street striping and traffic sign maintenance
- Snow plowing and removal
- Pothole repair
- Tree and stump removal
- Catch basin cleaning
- Sewer maintenance
- And of course, street sweeping

Bloomfield parking ordinance 254-20A and 254-56 (which primarily regulate alternate-side-of-the-street parking) are enforced year-round to allow crews to perform their varied duties.

The Police Department appreciates residents' cooperation in respecting the ordinances throughout the year.

Information

Alternate Side Parking Regulations will be suspended on major holidays listed because of snow, inclement weather or other emergencies. Please visit our website at www.bloomfieldnjpd.com or dial 973-680-4141 for further information. TTF Deaf or Hearing-Impaired, dial (973-680-4141).

When No Stopping, No Standing or No Parking signs are posted, you CANNOT do the following:

- Stop to drop off or pick up passengers
- Stop to load or unload a package, merchandise at curbside
- Wait for any reason

Vehicles may be towed for Title 39 violations, suspended/ expired registration, 48-hour parking rule or missing/expired inspection stickers.

Double-parking of passenger vehicles is illegal at all times, including street cleaning days, regardless of location, purpose or duration. It is illegal to park within 10 feet of either side of a fire hydrant. An occupied, illegally parked vehicle causes the same safety hazard and congestion as an unoccupied vehicle. Be responsible and park legally.

What does it mean to abandon a motor vehicle?

Under Township Ordinance 540-2 a vehicle is considered abandoned when...

Any motor vehicle, omnibus, road tractor, trailer, truck, truck tractor and vehicle which:

- (1) Is parked without the current year's registration or identification markers as required by law.
- (2) Has been continuously parked in any public street or highway of the Township; on any municipally owned or operated parking lot; on any property which is owned, leased or maintained by the Township; on any property which is owned, leased or maintained by the Board of Education of the Township; or on any property which is owned, leased or maintained by the Board of Recreation Commissioners of the Township for a period of 48 hours.
- (3) Is so disabled as to constitute an obstruction to traffic, and the driver or person owning or in charge thereof neglects or refuses to move the same to a place where it will not obstruct traffic.
- (4) Is found to be mechanically inoperative.
- (5) Is found without one or more tires.

Any abandoned vehicle or vehicle with expired and/or suspended registration discovered in the township is subject to ticket and tow.
